1. LACCI Conference objetives

The objective of the Latin American Computational Intelligence Conference was to discuss the state-of-the-art research and developments in Computational Intelligence (Neural Networks, Fuzzy Logic, and Evolutionary Computation), as well as to share the knowledge about Computational Intelligence by presenting the algorithms, mathematical models and their application in different areas, such as pattern recognition, data mining, astronomy, biomedical science and engineering, signal processing, business intelligence, Games, Emergent Technologies, Intelligent Systems Applications, among others

We had 8 keynote speakers, 4 tutorials, 1 doctoral symposium, 3 doctoral proposals presentations, 1 theses competition, 57 guests registered, 42 papers presented, 5 session chairs and 10 organizing chairs.






