In University of Exeter, we had the IEEE CIS Distinguished Lecturer, Prof. Kay Chen Tan from City University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong SAR, delivered a very interesting and insightful lecture on "Advances in Artificial Intelligence for Identification of Autism Spectrum Disorder" on 29 November 2019 (Friday).

In the lecture, Prof. Kay Chen Tan provided a review of the research that has been conducted on the use of evolutionary computation and deep learning for solving various real-world application problems, especially the emerging topic, autism spectrum disorder.
